Section 6-302.01: Juvenile Intensive Probation Supervision Evidence-Based Practices

1. Effect of the proposal:

Revisions are to clarify case plan requirements and modifications of supervision levels that further supports evidence-based practices. Also, significant updates are a result of technical changes to Arizona Revised Statutes from SB1073.

2. Significant new or changed provisions:

Removed reference to .01 version since the Courts will be governed by this updated code under the old ACJA section number. The .01 version will be deleted.

A. Definitions

- New definitions – AZYAS, AZYAS certified staff, AZYAS disposition tool, courtesy probation supervision, guardian, juvenile case plan, out-of-state placement, and parental contact.
- Modified definitions – Collateral, JIPS team, juvenile intensive probation, out-of-home care, and visual contact.
- Removed/deleted definitions – Case plan, default, delinquency risk, law enforcement officer, petition, referral, target interventions, and youth assessment.

C. Purpose – Revised.

G. Eligibility Requirements for JIPS (proposed subsection)

(4-6, 9) – current subsections removed.

(4)(a-e) – new subsection clarified.

I. JIPS Caseload (proposed subsection) – Moved content in current subsection K (active and inactive caseloads) to newly proposed subsection I; revised content.

J. Program Operations (proposed subsection) – Significant reorganization (same content)

(1)(a-o) – Revised case plan development deadline from 30 days to 45 days from disposition; clarifying the specific AZYAS tool to be used; modify supervision level based on juvenile’s case plan and behavior goals; encourage juvenile’s engagement with prosocial activities; supervisor approval of supervision level modifications; require supervisor quality assurance checks; moved content in current subsection (M)(6) to subsection (J)(1)(o).

(2)(a-r) – case plan requirements; engagement of juvenile’s parents; modification of supervision level or termination of probation based on case plan progress.

(3)(a-b), (4-5) – Removed due to duplicated content.

N. JIPS Placement (current subsection) – removed due to duplicated content.

K. Minimum Supervision Requirements (proposed subsection) – moved content in current subsection O (Minimum Supervision Requirements) to newly proposed subsection K; reorganized content.

(2) - Modify supervision level based on juvenile's progress with conditions of probation and case plan.

(3-5) – Newly disposition JIPS juveniles are intended to start on supervision level 1 and progress to level 2 and 3 based on case plan progress or modified as a graduated response.

(6-7) – Created new supervision levels of detention, out-of-home care, out-of-state placement, or juveniles in adult jail prior to conviction.
