c. Limited Jurisdiction Criminal. Legal paraprofessionals may render authorized services in criminal misdemeanor matters before a municipal or justice court of this state where, upon conviction, a penalty of incarceration is not at issue, whether by law or by agreement of the prosecuting authority and trial court. Legal paraprofessionals may also render authorized services and represent a defendant at an initial appearance and at other bail review hearings in a criminal matter pursuant to Arizona Rules of Criminal Procedure Rule 4.2 and for the limited purpose of advocating pre-trial release of the defendant under Rule 6.1(c).
